Order No. 16	29.07.2026	Plaintiff along with counsel present. Defendant through district attorney present. On examination of the pleadings and the material available on record, it appears that the present matter falls within the definition of a commercial dispute as provided under Sections 2(c) and 2(d) of the Commercial Courts Act. Consequently, this Court lacks jurisdiction to entertain and decide the present suit. Since the dispute is essentially a consumer dispute, this Court has no jurisdiction to entertain the present proceedings. The proper forum for adjudication of the matter is the Consumer Court having territorial and pecuniary jurisdiction. Accordingly, the plaint is ordered to be returned to the plaintiff for presentation before the competent Consumer Court, in accordance with law.
