One Zeeshan Haider filed special attorney on behalf of petitioners, which is placed on file. Ex-parte arguments heard and record perused.

Through this order, this Court is going to dispose of an application submitted by the petitioner for issuance of letter of administration in respect of movable property left by the deceased Muqadas Khan i.e. Bolan/Suzuki white color, Chassis No. SV308PK01078000, Engine No. PKT 961556 and Model 2017. That said deceased died on 03.04.2026 that petitioners namely Mst: Bibi Irzadi Jan (Widow), Mst: Nadia Khan (daughter), Mst: Haseena Alam (daughter), Mst: Maryam Begum (daughter), Mst: Shabana Begum (daughter), Mst: Nimra Batool (daughter) and Muhammad Ali Khan (son) are legal heir of the said deceased and there is no other legal heirs except the petitioner; that petitioners are entitled to obtain letter of administration in respect of the aforementioned vehicle, hence, the instant petition is filed.

Respondents, as a general public was served through proclamation but none did attend, hence, was placed and proceeded against ex-parte.

Petitioners produced three witnesses before the court.

Zeeshan Haider attorney for petitioners appeared and deposed as PW-01. He stated that husband of petitioner died on 03.04.2026. Death certificate is Ex.PW-1/1. One Suzuki vehicle having registration No.

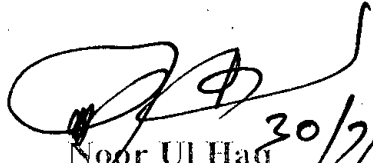
AGA-185, Engine No. PKT961556, Chassis No. SV308PK01078000 is registered in the name of husband of petitioner Bibi Irzadi Jan. Registration Card is Ex.PW-1/3. Copy of his CNIC is Ex.PW-1/4 and copy of CNIC of petitioner Irazadi Jan is Ex.PW-1/5. He lastly requested for issuance of letter of administration certificate in favour of petitioners.

Istikhar Ali and Waseem Hassan appeared and deposed as PW-02 & PW-03 respectively. They stated that they endorse the statement of the Special Attorney for petitioners and lastly requested for issuance of letter of administration certificate in favour of petitioners. Copies of their CNICs are Ex.PW-2/1 & Ex. PW-3/1 respectively.

As obvious, there is nothing to rebut the contention of the petitioner. In the absence of any rebutting evidence, petition in hand is accepted and letter of administration be issued in favour of the petitioner on furnishing surety bond/undertaking in the sum of Rs: 30,00,000/- with two local & reliable sureties to the effect that if there appear any other legal heirs of the deceased except above named legal heirs, she would be responsible to the court, along with a blank stamp paper.
