One Zeeshan Haider filed special power of attorney on behalf of petitioners. Ex-parte arguments heard and record perused.

Petitioner namely Mst: Bibi Irzadi Jan widow of Muqadas Khan, R/O Qaum Bar Muhammad Khel, Tappa Abdul Aziz Khel, Kuriz Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai has filed the instant petition for grant of Guardianship Certificate regarding her minor's children namely Muhammad Ali Khan. It has been alleged that petitioner is the widow of deceased Muqadas Khan who died on 03.04.2026. It is further alleged that petitioner is the natural guardian of minors named above and the interest of petitioner and minors are common and there is no conflict in their interest, therefore, she may be appointed as guardian of minors named above.

Respondents /public at large were summoned through publication in daily "AWSAF" but no one appeared before the court to contest the instant application, hence, they were placed and proceeded ex-parte.

Thereafter, petitioner produced three witnesses.

Special attorney for petitioners appeared and deposed as PW-01. He stated that husband of petitioner Muqadas Khan died on 03.04.2026. Death certificate is Ex.PW-1/1. Deceased Muqadas Khan has seven children. FRC is Ex.PW-1/2. Muhammad Ali Khan is minor while rest of the children are major. Copy of his CNIC is Ex.PW-1/3 and copy of CNIC of petitioner is Ex.PW-1/4. He lastly requested for issuance of Guardianship Certificate in favour of petitioner.

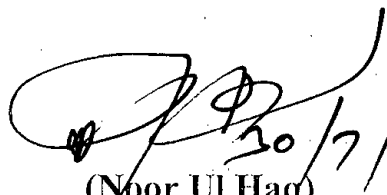

Istikhar Ali and Waseem Hassan appeared and deposed as PW-02 & PW-03 respectively. They stated that husband of petitioner on 03.04.2026. Petitioner has one minor children namely Muhammad Ali Khan while of her children are major. Photocopy of their CNICs are Ex-PW-2/1 & Ex-PW-3/1. They lastly requested for issuance of guardianship certificate in favour of petitioner.

There is nothing on the case file to suggest that there is conflict of interest between petitioner and her minor children, hence, the Guardianship Certificate, as prayed for, is granted in favour of petitioner subject to furnishing surety bond in the sum of Rs: 100,000/- (One Lac Rupees) with two local and reliable sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court with a blank stamp paper. The sureties must be men of means.
