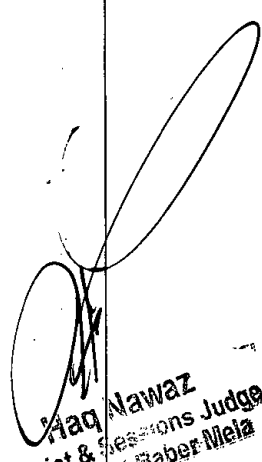


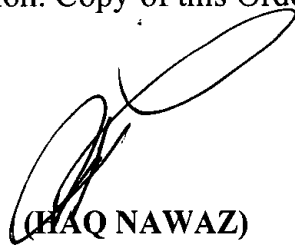

The local police on receipt of information reached THQ Hospital and found Said Nawaz s/o Muhammad Khan, Kaptan s/o Dost Muhammad, Muhammad Kamran s/o Muhammad Khan and Muhammad Ullah s/o Muhabbat Khan in injured condition where the injured, Muhammad Ullah vide Daily Diary (DD) No. 13 of 14.04.2025 at about 0940 hours made a report to the local police to the fact that the accused/petitioners and co-accused had placed stones (crush) in his field the day before the incident, and that on the eventful  Haq Nawaz District & Sessions Judge Orakzai at Baber Mela

Contin. Order No.03		day he was busy clearing those stones when the duly armed accused/petitioners arrived and hurled stones at them (DD's complainant party), causing them to sustain injuries. They also made aerial firing to criminally intimate the injured/complainant. On the same day at about 0930 hours, in the emergency room of THQ Hospital, the accused/petitioner Mir Wali (complainant in FIR/injured) reported to the local police that on that day he along with his nephews was present at the front door of their residential house when Muhammad Ullah s/o Muhabbat Khan arrived there, put stones there and then opened fire on him when Mir Wali attempted to stop him; as a result, Mir Wali got hit and sustained injuries. Hence, the present FIR. Perusal of the case file shows that the instant report vide DD No. 13, was lodged against the FIR No. 30, Dated 14.04.2025, u/s 324 PPC of Police Station Kalaya. One of the injured, namely Muhammad Ullah s/o Muhabbat Khan was charged for causing firearm injury to the petitioner, Mir Wali. A total of 04 persons sustained injuries in the instant case; however, there injuries were reported to be simple in nature by the medical officer. Similarly, the allegations under Section 506 PPC also falls within first part of the said Section. Hence, all the offenses, for which the petitioners have been charged, are bailable in nature. Therefore, in the above circumstances and facts, the pre-arrest bail petition stands accepted and ad-interim pre-arrest bail granted earlier to the accused/petitioners is confirmed on the strength of existing bail bonds. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
