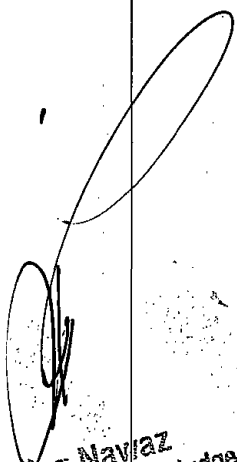

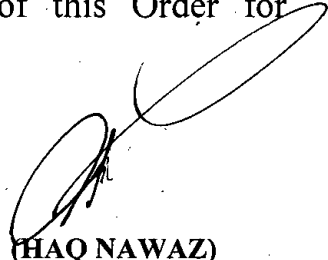

Order No.04		After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the case pertains to Police Station Dabori which falls within the criminal jurisdiction of Judicial Magistrate-II, Kalaya, as per Office Order Dated 09.10.2024, passed by my predecessor in office. The only reason, mentioned by the petitioner in his transfer application, is that he is residing at Hangu and attending the Court at Kalaya is inconvenient for him. On the other hand, the accused is the resident of village Dabori who may experience the similar inconvenience if the case was transferred to District Headquarter at Baber Mela. The learned counsel for the petitioner alleged threat to the life of petitioner while attending the Court at Kalaya but no such ground for transfer of the case was given in the application in hand. In view of the above, the application is dismissed. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
