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**ORDER**

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State and Khursheed Alam Advocate for accused/petitioner present.  
Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Aman Ullah** s/o Jameel Khan seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 12, Dated 25.01.2025 registered u/s 395/342/355/337-F(i) of Police Station Kalaya. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Khazir Khan, vide Daily Diary No. 07 of 26.12.2025 reported the matter to the police at 1100 hours that he along with a companion was riding a motorcycle from Anjani Bazar on 25.12.2025 at evening time. When they reached the spot at 1750 hours, five persons in possession of weapons were present there and stopped them by aiming pistol and Kalashnikov at them. After disembarking the complainant and his co-rider, the accused snatched a Vivo Y21T mobile and 01 lac cash from the complainant and an i-Tel mobile from his companion namely Sher Khan. They were blindfolded and taken into a room where the

  
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accused/petitioner and co-accused took off the shirts of complainant and Sher Khan and beat them with fists, sticks, batons and electric wires which caused them injuries. They were locked there for 03/04 hours and also made their video. The complainant and his fellow rider came back to their house. They identified four of the accused as Bakhtiar, Mujahid, Sher all sons of Murad Khan and Aman s/o Jameel while the fifth person was unknown. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR for wrongful confinement, snatching cash, mobile phones and causing injuries to the complainant and co-rider. However, according to School Identification Card, produced by counsel for the accused/petitioner, he is of the age of 13 years and 7 months. Moreover, co-accused with similar role has already been admitted to bail. Thus, the accused/petitioner is also entitled for the concession of bail on the basis of rule of consistency.

4. In view of above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like

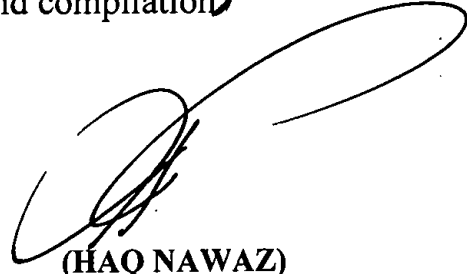
  
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amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties  
must be local, reliable and men of means.
