

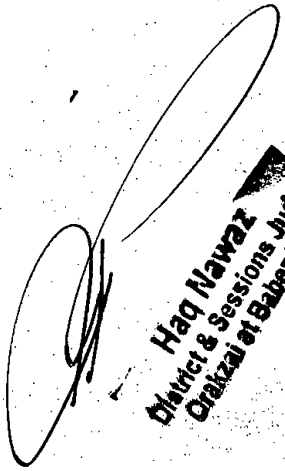

ORDER

Counsel for the accused/petitioners appeared through video link. Khan Ameer Advocate for complainant and Sr. PP, Abdul Qasim for the state present. Arguments heard and the record perused.

2. Accused/petitioners, **Bait Ullah** s/o Siraj Khan and **Siraj** s/o Noor Muhammad Khan seek their post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 24, Dated 14.08.2026, u/s 324/337-F(i)/34 PPC of Police Station Dabori. As per contents of the FIR, the local police, while responding to the information regarding the occurrence, rushed to Type-D Hospital Dabori on 14.08.2026 and found the injured Naeem Khan, Amjad Khan and Muhammad Idrees in the emergency room. The complainant/injured, Muhammad Idrees, reported the matter to the local police at 1650 hours that he along with Naeem Khan and Amjad Khan were preparing a cricket pitch when the accused/petitioners and co-accused, armed with sticks, arrived there and told them to stop preparing the pitch. The accused/petitioner Bait Ullah and co-accused attacked the complainant and

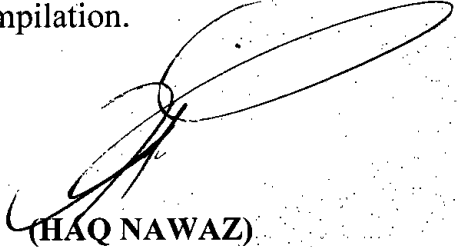
others with sticks while the accused/petitioner Siraj stabbed the injured Naeem with a knife causing him injuries.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the petitioner Bait Ullah is a juvenile. He has been attributed stick blows to injured Amjad who has not sustained any serious wound. Whereas the accused/petitioner Siraj is charged for inflicting stab wounds to injured Naeem. His medical report supports the allegations. The offence falls within the prohibitory clause of section 497 CrPC. The petitioner Siraj is, therefore, not entitled to the concession of bail.

4. The application to the extent of accused/petitioner Bait Ullah is accepted and he is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 80,000/- with two sureties, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.

5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
