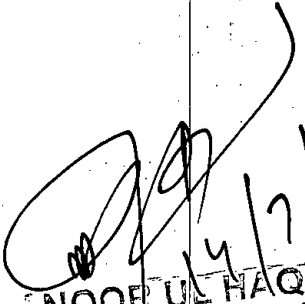

Order 100	14.07.2026	Parties present alongwith counsels. Vide this order the Court intends to dispose of instant application for contempt of Court filed by the petitioners. Arguments heard and record perused. Perusal of the record reveals that petitioners had stated in the instant contempt of Court application that the respondents in violation of the orders of the Court, alienated the suit property, while they were restrained from further alienation. Furthermore, parties were refrained from interference with the existing possession of each other in the suit property, however, one Rehmat Ullah shows himself as Abdul Zari and interfering in the suit property. Upon the same FIR no. 62 dated 26.07.2025 under section 324/109/34 PPC registered in PS Mishti Mela, thus the respondents have committed the contempt of the court orders. Contrary to this the respondent stated that he has not violated any order passed by the Court. In given circumstances, perusal of previous order sheets reveal that after institution of instant contempt of court petition, the bailiff was directed to submit his inquiry report after spot inspection. Accordingly, bailiff visited the

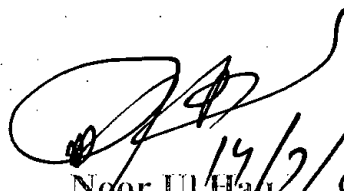
spot on 03.11.2025 and submitted his detailed report before this Court, wherein he stated that neither there is any new construction done nor is in progress. Moreover, similar contempt petition has been filed by opposite party, which shows that they are dragging each other in unnecessary petitions. The ownership of property or the multiple stances of the parties are yet to be proved by them. At this stage, the report of the bailiff is clear. Nothing at this stage has been brought on record to show that any violation of the court order has been committed.

In light of above discussion, instant contempt of court petition is hereby dismissed. No order as to costs.
