Attorney for petitioner alongwith counsel present. Publication received but no one appeared on behalf of public at large hence placed and proceeded ex-parte. Ex-parte evidence recorded and closed. Ex-parte arguments heard and record perused.

Petitioner namely Mst. Ajmeer Sultan widow of Mumtaz Ali, R/O Qaum Sepoy, Tappa Mitakhan Khel, Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai has filed the instant petition for grant of Guardianship Certificate regarding her minor's children namely Hurain Zahra and Yaman Zahra. It has been alleged that petitioner is the widow of deceased Mumtaz Ali who died on 08.05.2026. It is further alleged that petitioner is the natural guardian of minors named above and the interest of petitioner and minors are common and there is no conflict in their interest, therefore, she may be appointed as guardian of minors named above.

Respondents /public at large were summoned through publication in daily "AAJ" but no one appeared before the court to contest the instant application, hence, they were placed and proceeded ex-parte.

Thereafter, petitioner produced three witnesses.

Amir Ali and Aqib Ali appeared and deposed as PW-02 & PW-03 respectively. They stated that husband of petitioner died on 08.05.2026.

Petitioner have two minor's children namely Hurain Zahra and Yaman Zahra.

Photocopy of their CNICs are Ex-PW-2/1 & Ex-PW-3/1.

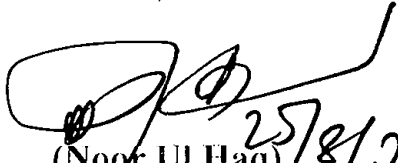

Special attorney for petitioners appeared and deposed as PW-03. He stated that petitioner has two minor's children namely Hurain Zahra and Yaman Zahra. Form-B is Ex.PW-3/1. Special attorney is Ex.PW-3/2 and copy of his CNIC is Ex.PW-3/3. He lastly requested for issuance of Guardianship Certificate in favour of petitioners.

There is nothing on the case file to suggest that there is conflict of interest between petitioner and her minor children, hence, the Guardianship Certificate, as prayed for, is granted in favour of petitioner subject to furnishing surety bond in the sum of Rs: 500,000/- (Five Lac Rupees) with two local and reliable sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court with a blank stamp paper. The sureties must be men of means.
