Today, surety Muhammad Hakeem alongwith Mr. Haroon advocate appeared before the court and requested for requisitioning the record. Request allowed. Case file requisitioned for today. Surety Muhammad Shamshir absent.

Record reveals that Muhammad Hakeem and Muhammad Shamshir Shah stood sureties for the accused Muhammad Ikhlaj for an amount of Rs. 80,000/- each in case FIR No. 81, dated 18.02.2025, U/S 11(i)4 CNSA PS Kalaya. During the trial, they failed to produce the said accused before the court so they were proceeded U/S 514 Cr. PC. Surety Muhammad Hakeem requested for lenient view. As per contention of surety he stood surety for the accused on humanitarian ground and that he has not stood surety for personal and financial gain. Furthermore, accused Muhammad Ikhlaj is the brother of surety Muhammad Hakeem.

There is nothing on record showing that the surety Muhammad Hakeem has gained any financial benefits from the accused. Prima facie, he stood surety for the accused on social ground. Hence, a lenient view is taken of the matter and each surety is burdened with the fine of Rs. 4,000/- (Four thousand). Surety Muhammad Hakeem stated that co-surety Muhammad Shamshir is his friend and requested that he will pay for himself

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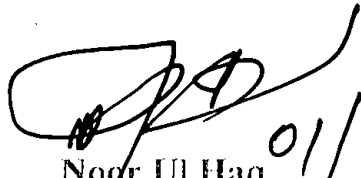
