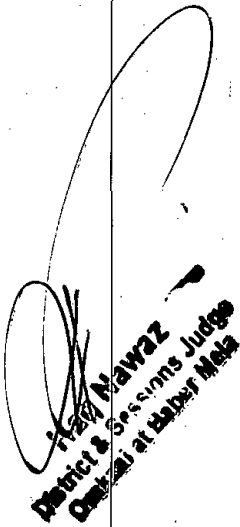

Order No.04	02.09.2026	Accused/petitioner, Alamzeb on ad-interim pre-arrest bail along with counsel present. Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the state present. Complainant absent. Arguments heard and record perused. The accused/petitioner seeks his pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 51, Dated 02.07.2026, u/s 324/34 PPC of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of the FIR, the local police, while responding to the information regarding the occurrence, reached DHQ Hospital Mishti Mela on 07.02.2026 and found the injured Muhammad Shahid in the emergency room. He reported the matter to the local police at 1945 hours that he was taking cattle to his house from nearby fields on the eventful day when the accused/petitioner and co-accused made firing at him at 1810 hours with the intention to kill him and that he sustained injuries from the firing of accused/petitioner. They also made firing upon house of the complainant. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the instant FIR for the commission of offence. Medical report supports the prosecution's case. Counsel for the accused/petitioner failed to point out any malafidi or ulterior motive on behalf of the complainant or local police for implicating him in the instant case.
