

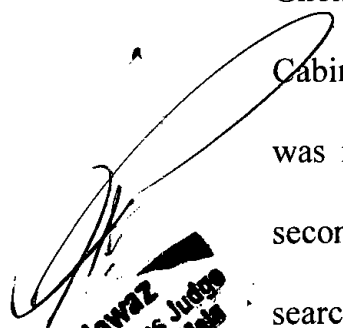

ORDER

Arguments heard and record perused.

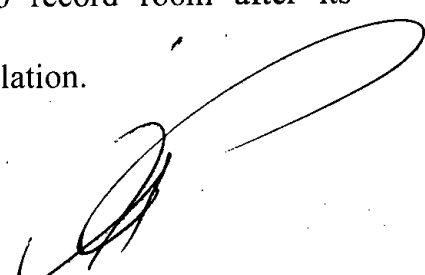
2. Accused/petitioner, **Muhammad Siraj** s/o Muhammad Ishaq seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 26, Dated 30.08.2026 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Ghiljo. As per contents of the FIR, the complainant, Naseeb Khan, along with other police contingent, during surveillance duty, laid a barricade at Ghondake Dabori Road on 30.08.2026 when Double Cabin Pick-Up bearing Registration No. B-2309/Kohat was intercepted at 1040 hours. A person occupying the second seat was deboarded. He was subjected to personal search but nothing incriminating was recovered from his possession. The complainant found a plastic sack beneath the second seat of the vehicle. From the said sack, the complainant recovered 10 packets of chars, weighing 1100 grams each, making a total of 11,000 grams. The person disclosed his name as Muhammad Siraj s/o Muhammad Ishaq while the driver of the vehicle


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disclosed his name as Asim Khan s/o Ajat Khan. Hence,
the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR. However, the recovery memo was not signed by one of the marginal witnesses, as evident from the bail order of co-accused dated 04.09.2026 passed in BA No. 209/4 of 2026. According to the card of arrest, the accused/petitioner is of the age of 15/16 years. The petitioner has therefore a right to be released on bail. Reliance is placed on Cr. Misc. (Bail Application) No. 1106-P/2025 of the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar.
4. In view of the above, the application is accepted and the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
