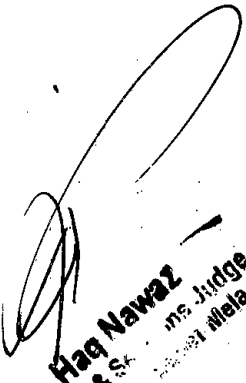

ORDER

and Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the state present.
Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Muhammad Ibrahim** s/o Ikhtiar

Gul seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 61, Dated 15.08.2026 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (d) CNSA and 337-G/279/427 PPC of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of the FIR, the complainant, SHO Muhammad Younas, along with other police contingent, laid a barricade at Sanghra Mor on main road Mishti Mela to Kalaya on 15.08.2026 when a motorcyclist was coming from Mishti Mela at 1100 hours, who was having a white sack on fuel tank of the motorcycle. He was signaled to stop, but the rider accelerated the motorcycle and tried to escape. He was chased in an official vehicle and the rider fell down after covering some distance which resulted into his injuries. The local police overpowered him. From the said sack, the complainant recovered 07-kg chars. Hence, the present FIR.

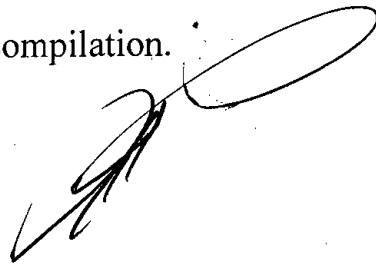

MUHAMMAD IBRAHIM VS THE STATE

G/279/427 PPC, Police Station: Mishti Mela

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the accused/petitioner seeks acceptance of the instant bail application on medical ground. The report of a doctor regarding injuries of the accused/petitioner was requisitioned. According to which, the left arm of accused/petitioner is fractured. The injuries require specialized treatment and the accused/petitioner cannot be properly treated within the jail premises; therefore, keeping him in jail would likely to be hazardous to his life.
4. In view of the above, the application is accepted and the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
