Order 02	24.08.2026	Amir Khan OII of PS Mishti Mela present. In pursuance of the show-cause notice, Amir Khan, OII, PS Mishti Mela, appeared and submitted his written reply. In his response, the concerned officer has acknowledged the importance of timely submission of challans and has undertaken before this Court that, in future, the challans in all newly registered criminal cases shall be submitted before the competent Court within fourteen (14) days from the registration of the respective cases. He has further undertaken that, in the event of failure to comply with the said undertaking, the Court shall be at liberty to take appropriate action against him in accordance with law. The undertaking furnished by the OII has been considered in the light of the purpose of the present proceedings. The object of issuing the show-cause notice is not merely to proceed against an officer, but also to ensure due compliance with the law, expeditious submission of challans and proper administration of criminal justice. Timely submission of challans is essential for avoiding unnecessary delay in criminal proceedings and for safeguarding the rights of accused/prisoners. In view of the categorical undertaking furnished by Amir

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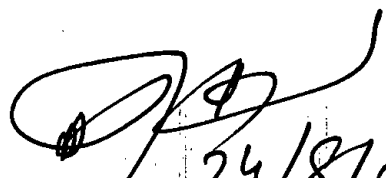
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Khan, OII, Police Station Mishti Mela, and his assurance to strictly comply with the requirement of timely submission of challans in future, the request made by him is accepted. However, it is made clear that the undertaking given before this Court shall be treated as binding upon him and any future failure or negligence in this regard may result in initiation of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

Consequently, the present inquiry/show-cause proceedings are disposed of without any further proceedings at this stage. The concerned OII is directed to remain vigilant and ensure strict compliance with his undertaking in all future cases.
